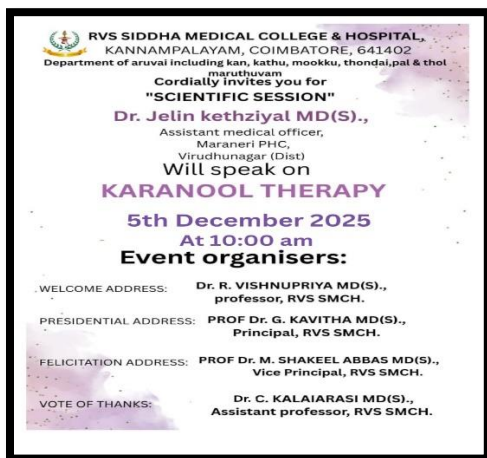

6. Health-awareness programmes - In 2025 RVS SMCH undertook comprehensive health-awareness programmes aimed at fostering improved public health literacy.

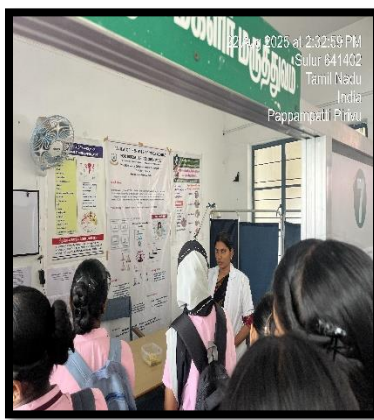

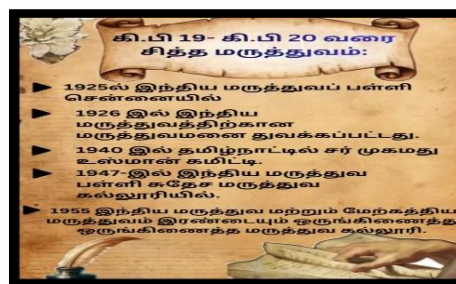
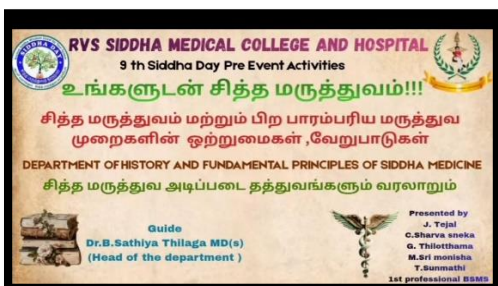

10. Pre Siddha Day Activities

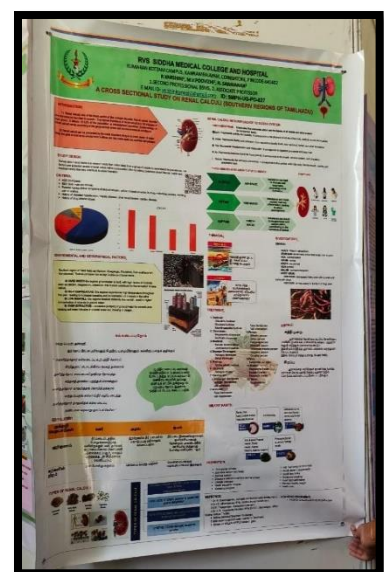
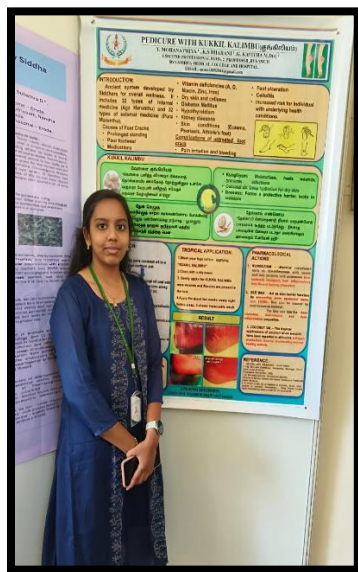
